A.D.Jeyem Pandian and Dr.A.D.Jegadheeswar founded this college in the name of their parents **A.Duraisamy Nadar Maragathavalliammal** in 1975 the period, in which access to higher education remained a day dream to the women folk of this rural area. Thanks to the foresight of the visionary founders. The portals of Higher Education were wide open to them. Now under the patronage of our Founder President the college has recorded exponential growth. The college is offering 16 UG Programmes 07 PG Programmes 03 M.Phil Programmes and 06 Ph.D. programmes.

This academic year commenced on 16.06.2016. The college has both Aided and Self Financing Sections. Total student strength this year is 1796 including 1565

UG students 202 PG students and 29 M.Phil Research Scholars. 123 teaching faculty and 60 non-teaching are rendering their valuable service.
