Department of Chemistry offered Consultancy Service to the farmers by analysing soil and Water samples.The Soil samples were collected from 20 locations in Nagapattinam region of cauvery delta zone. These samples were analysed for its physical, chemical properties and major nutrient status. From the results of the study, the acidity,neutrality and alkalinity of soil is measured in terms of pH.

In the present investigation water samples were collected from 10 locations in and around Nagapattinam region. To find out their suitability for irrigation in agricultural fields, the water samples were analysed for pH, Electrical Conductivity, cation and anions.

After **analyzing** the samples, results obtained were investigated for its nutrient content, crop cultivation and suitable result recommendations were given to the individuals concerned.
