COURSE FEEDBACK FROM OUT GONE STUDENTS

(2020-2021)

Student's feedback regarding course content, learning resources, continuous internal assessment, and quality of teaching and examination pattern were collected. 272 questionnaires were distributed to the out gone students at random basis. They were collected and analyzed. The following conclusions were inferred.

- 93 % of the students felt that the curriculum was useful and complete. Only 7% of the students felt that the curriculum was not useful and complete.
- 96.7 % of the students had stated that the syllabus was given at the beginning of the semester.
- 79.4 % of the students felt that the syllabus was fully covered and 18% of them felt that only 75-90% of the syllabus was covered.
- 68.5 % of the students were of opinion that the library facilities available in the college is excellent. 24.5 % of the students felt that it was adequate and 7% stated that it was not adequate.
- 56 % of the students were of the opinion that the digital library facility available in the college was excellent. 32.2 % of the students felt that it was adequate and 11.8% felt that it was not adequate.
- 94.9 % of the students were in favour of continuous internal assessment and only 5.1 % of them expressed the disapproval.
- 100% of the students were of the opinion that the teachers were impartial.
- 58.8 % of the students felt that the examination pattern was excellent. 36.8 % felt that it was good. 4.4 % felt that it was fair.
- 98.2 % of the students felt that the approach of the teachers was good.
- 98.2 % of the students stated that the subject was taught in English and 1.8 % stated that it was not in through English.
- 98.9 % of the students were of the opinion that opportunity was given to them conduct seminar.

- 100 % of the students were fully satisfied with the practical classes.
- 84.9% of the students felt that the benefit and derived through the curriculum was satisfactory. 12.1% of them felt that it was fair and 3 % felt that the benefit and derived through curriculum was minimal.
- 89.3 % of the students were of the opinion that the curriculum was useful both in getting job opportunities and also to become entrepreneurs and 10.7 % of the students felt that it was not useful.
- 90.1 % of the students were satisfied with the skill based courses offered and 9.9 % of them were not satisfied with it.
- 74.3 % of the students felt that focus of the curriculum was on leadership and personality development and 25.7 % felt that it was not so.

INFRASTRUCTURE

- 62.5% of the students opined that class room and furniture facility were good.29 % of them felt that they were adequate and 8.5 % felt that they were not adequate.
- 71.3 % of the students were of the opinion that they were satisfied with the laboratory equipments computer facilities and other facilities and 28 .7% of the students felt they were not satisfied.
- 93.4 % of the students felt that they were satisfied with the books and magazines available in the library were satisfactory and 6.6 % felt that they were not satisfied.
- 82 % of the students were of the opinion that they facilities provided for sports and games and practice were satisfied and 18 % felt that they were not satisfied.
- 80.1% of the students opined that the amenities like drinking water, sanitary condition and safety available in the college were satisfied and 19.9 % felt that it was not satisfied.
- 47.8 % of the students felt that the canteen facilities were satisfied and 52.2 % felt that they were not satisfied.
- 80.1 % of the students opined that the response they received from the administrative staff was satisfied and 19.9 % felt that they were not satisfied.

Action taken:

Out gone students wanted to improve canteen facilities. Report of the feedback from out gone students was submitted to the principal for further action.
