


National Anthem








Activity: Cleanliness drive 2022 for Swachh Bharat



HANDS ON TRAINING PROGRAMME

PCR TECHNIQUES AND ITS APPLICATION IN AQUACULTURE GENETICS RESEARCH AND AQUACULTURE PATHOLOGY

Hands on training programme on PCR techniques and its application in aquaculture genetics research and aquaculture pathology organized by Rajiv Gandhi center for aquaculture Sirkali, Tamilnadu, India is given to 10 students and one staff members of department of biochemistry from 8.3.2022 to 11.3.2022. They demonstrated sample collection from muscle crab and DNA extraction from muscle crab tissues agarose gel preparation. Then the students practiced about sample collection and analysis. ITS-1 PCR techniques and thermal cycler methods are explained Davission kit by the trainers. The students learnt about total genomic DNA extraction from muscle &pleopods tissues, sample using DNA easy blood tissues kit and sample loading and running process to agarose gel, and visualize band conformation through UV light.

From 10.3.2022 to 11.3.2022 hands on training programme on PCR techniques and its application in aquaculture pathology is conducted. The trainers explained about various types of diseases like etc., to identify diseases davission fixative kit method is used. Then DNA extraction by GT-buffer by using silica gel method is shown in PPT. this method to identify both DNA and RNA level. So many apparatus and mini-instruments handled. They also explained about calculation of WWSV detection protocol& to lean about isolation of bacteria and vibrio colonies colour identification.

Finally visited the instruments lab certain sophisticated instruments, miniinstruments. Where the students individually done the analysis. This hands-on training is much useful and everyone can do the sampling identification and DNA extraction individually.



TESTING OF BASIC COMPONENTS AND INSTRUMENTS


