



Background

DMI organization is based on Self Help Groups (SHG) approach and was implemented in partnership with Mahalir Thittam, IFAD, Child line 1098 and Community based organizations. Today the SHG movement is very vibrant movement spread across in three blocks of the Nagai District with nearly 2,270 women as members in 145 SHGs. The main functions are to create livelihood support to women and train them in economic development activities.

A.Duraisamy Nadar Margathavalliammal College for Women (ADMC) Velliplayam Nagapattinam represented by its Principal is a well-known college of this region. The college has played a pioneering role since its inception in spreading higher education to the women. It was established in the International Women's Year 1975, for the benefit of the young girls at the coastal town Nagapattinam. Focusing on women empowerment, the college firmly believes that in an ideal society women should enjoy the same opportunities rights and obligations in all spheres of life so that they get autonomy to manage their own lives. For this reason woman empowerment is vital to sustainable development and the realization of human rights for all.



- 3. The validity of this MoU is for a period of 3 years from the date of its signing.


