Subsequently in the year 2013, the scope was</p>	<p>enlarged cover direct payment to beneficiaries under both plan and non- plan schemes.</p> <p>The latest enhancement in the functionalities of PFMS commenced in late 2014, wherein it has been envisaged that digitization of accounts shall be achieved through PFMS and the additional functionalities would be built into PFMS in different stages. Beginning with Pay & Accounts Officers payments, the O/o CGA did further value addition by proposing to bring in more financial activities of the GOI in the ambit of the project.</p> <p>The primary object of PFMS is to facilitate sound Public Financial Management System for GOI by establishing an efficient fund flow system as well as a payment cum accounting network. PFMS provides various stakeholders with a real time, reliable and meaningful management information system and an effective decision support system, as part of the Digital India Initiative of GOI. The biggest strength of PFMS is its integration with the core banking system in the country. As a result, PFMS has the unique capability to push online payments to almost every beneficiary / vendor. A present, PFMS interface is having interface in addition to the Core Banking System(CBS) of all Public Sector Banks, Regional Rural Banks, major private sector banks, reserve bank of India, India post and Cooperative Banks.</p> <p>SCOPE OF THE WORKSHOPS</p> <p>To resolve issues relating to All the scheme from which the institution would be receiving funds. IQAC organized a Webinar on “Investor Awareness Programme by BSE Investors Protection Fund ” on 11.05.2022 through Zoom Meet. Mr.B.P.Anand, Certified Trainer & Assessor, Learning and Development Consultant, Certified Business Insurance Analyst, bangalore was the resource person. The resource person presented on the basic guidelines for investing and the responsibilities of investors.
