




ATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME ENVIRONMENTAL DAY - TREE PLANTATION CAMPAIGN










PG AND RESEARCH DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

Eight Students participated in the programme and presented their ideas.




ORIENTATION PROGRAMME FOR ALL THE 1ST YEAR UG STUDENTS




