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MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF STUDIES MEETING MA HISTORY

Mrs.R. Alamelu, HOD of History made arrangement for the P.G. History Board of Studies on 03/10/2023 at 10.00 AM. She welcomed the subject experts and introduced them to the faculty members.

The following suggestions were given by the subjects experts..

Dr. T. Asokan suggested that the paper entitled "Socio-Cultural History of Tamil Nadu From 1565 CE - 2000 CE" (Core Course VI) of II Semester has vast portions. Hence, the period could be changed from 1565 to 1947 CE. He also suggested that as the History of Tamil Nadu is asked in the competitive exams we can incorporate the History of Contemporary Tamil Nadu as one course programme. Further, he said that the interpretation on concepts is essential for the P.G students rather than syllabus coverage.

Dr. K. Ashok has suggested that the overall course objectives need to be re-worked. Besides, he has given inputs on general programme outcome, programme specific outcome, and course outcome. He has also advised the faculties to work on the basis of units-wise.

- In Core Course I -History of Ancient India Prehistory to 1206 CE, the members have changed and incorporated few topics to the Unit V.
- In Core Course 2 -Socio-cultural History of Tamil Nadu upto 1565 CE, the members have changed and incorporated few topics in the Unit IV &V.
- In Core Course 3 -History of World Civilization upto 1453 CE, the members have deleted and incorporated few topics in the Unit V.
- In Major Based Electives I -Archaeology, changes were made in Unit II & IV.
- In Major Based Elective, II Tourism Management, changes were made in Unit I& V.
- In Core Course 5 Socio-cultural History of Tamil Nadu upto 1565 2000 CE of Semester II, major periodical changes in title has made. Further, new topics like social reformers and nationalism and regionalism were incorporated.
- In the Major Based Elective 2 History of Journalism of Semester II was swapped with the paper Archives Keeping.
- In the Skill Enhancement Course 2 Introduction to Museology, few topics were incorporated and deleted in Unit IV & V. Members suggested important reference books and author names.
- In Major Based Elective Course Indian Constitution of II Semesterfew changes were made.

Board of Studies Economics also discussed Tamil Nadu State Council for Higher Education (TANSCHE) syllabus for PG Course in Economics and finally approved the syllabus and suggested to opt Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) in Social Entrepreneurship in Health and Hygiene. (Learning of any fine arts). The said suggestion was approved by all.

Dr.P. Natarajamoorthy, Associate Professor/University Nominee was requested to provide Internship Training to UG and PG Students of Economics and he has graciously accepted to extend the facility to this Department students.

- Another suggestion was made based on elaborate discussion to introduce Marshall and Hicksian Reformulation Theory instead of Hicksian measures.

Suggestions given by the BOS Committee members:

M.Sc Mathematics:

1. The textbook for the Course (Core III) Ordinary Differential Equations should be changed as E.A.Coddington, "An Introduction to Ordinary Differential Equations".

2. Existing syllabus and Textbook Ian Sneddon "Elements of Partial Differential Equations" to be continued for the Course (Core VI) as the textbook suggested by TANSCHE is not available.

3. It is advised to include reading materials such as MIT open sources, NPTEL video lectures etc. in all the courses.

4. In all courses it is advised to incorporate a small unit, Professional component in the content.

6. The content for the course "Industrial Mathematics" to be made relevant to address some issues related to industries.

7. Rework the mapping of Programme Outcome and Programme Specific Outcomes with Course Learning Outcomes.

8. For the course "Mathematics for Life Sciences" it is advised to include the content from Biological Mathematics.

9. The title "Statistics for Life and Social Science" should be changed as " Mathematics for Social Science".

10. The Title "Mathematics for Advance Research Studies" should be changed as "Mathematics for NET/ UGC-CSIR/TNPSC"



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B.Sc Mathematics:

1. Textbook should match with the Unit wise arrangement of the content for the course (CORE I) "Algebra and Trigonometry".

2. For the course "Analytical Geometry (Two and Three Dimensions)" book for stufy can be confined to two or three textbooks.

3. In all the courses refer reading material MIT open sources, NPTEL video lectures. (Mention

3 to 4 videos in specific)

4. All the courses should be uniformly unitized with five units.

5. Uniformity should be followed in book reference (Book Title, Author name, Publisher, Year of Publication)

6. Need not indicate k level prior to the course outcomes.

7. For the Allied courses offered to other departments, suitable indications must be provided.

The Board thoroughly scrutinized the programme Structure, Course title, Course Content, Unitization, Instruction hours and Credits.




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The following suggestions were given by the Board of Studies External Experts:

- B.A. English:
 - Semester I paper 1.6 in Part IV Skill Enhancement course I Functional English is introduced as Non-Major Elective course.
 - ➤ 1.8 For all Skill Enhancement Foundation Course English for Careers is introduced.
 - Semester II 2.6 Part IV in Skill Enhancement Course II English for Business is introduced as Non-Major Elective course.

- 4. M.Sc., Computer Science
- 5. M.C.A

The following suggestions were given by the Board members and Industrial Experts. These suggestion could be considered and incorporated.

Suggestions:

- Subject Expert Dr.T.Velmurugan suggested that total credits for B.Sc., Computer Science, B.Sc., Information technology and BCA should not exceed 145 credits, minimum 135 credits.
- 2. Subject Expert Dr.T.Velmurugan suggested that 75% of the Syllabi should be followed as TANSHE pattern in the remaining 25% title and syllabi may be changed as needed.
- 3. In Semester VI, minimum two credits may be given for Extension Activity.







SEMESTER – II

GCC- III – Biochemical and Microbial Changes in Fish, Unit – 5 has been removed. The remaining contents of the unit have been integrated into Unit – 1 to Unit – 5. Both theory and practical courses have been introduced (60 marks for theory and 40 marks for practical).

GCC - IV, Preprocessing of fish and Shellfish: In Unit – 1, spoilage & pathogenic microorganisms have been removed. In Unit – 3, the Importance of quality, definitions, terminologies, and Quality dimensions of seafood – Sensory, Intrinsic, quantitative, and affective parameters have been



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excluded. Instead, intrinsic and extrinsic parameters affecting the quality of fresh fish are preferred.

In Unit -5, "Design and Layout of Fish Processing Establishment" is suggested in place of planning and layout, equipment construction, and design.

SCC – IV – Chilling Technology: In the practical syllabus, a visit to chill storage units for fish is preferred over a visit to chill rooms in fish processing plants.

SCC – V- Fish Freezing Technology: In Unit – 3, the Freeze-drying process has been removed. Additionally, in Unit – 5, topics such as transportation of frozen fish to foreign markets, chill & cold storage of fish, insulation thickness, containers for storage and transport of fish, different types of insulated boxes, and HACCP in the freezing industry have been eliminated. "Packaging requirements for frozen fishery products" are suggested instead.

SEMESTER – IV

SCC – X- Cured and Dried Fishery Products: Instead of the Smoking method, both Cold and Hot methods, "Sun drying of fish, Smoke curing of fish, and Salt curing of fish" are introduced.

Instead of Processing and principles of cold, cooked, and fried marinades, "Preparation of fish marinades" is preferred. The Production of Fish and Shellfish pickles has been moved to SCC – XI – Fish Product and Byproducts Technology.

Instead of shelf life, - Packaging requirements for dry, cured, and fermented products, "Packaging methods for various fish products" are preferred.

SCC – XI – Fish Product and Byproducts Technology: Traditional methods of fish preservation, methods of fish drying, and document preparation for any product have been removed. Instead of the Production of fish oil by the soxhlet extraction method, "Preparation of fish meal and fish oil"



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is preferred. "Preparation of Seaweed Products" replaces Culturing of Seaweed. Additionally, the Preparation of fish and shellfish pickles is suggested, and "Preparation of value-added fish products" is preferred instead of the preparation of any fish product / Value Addition.

SCC – XII – Storage and Transportation of Fishery Products: Methods to reduce losses during storage and transportation have been removed. Chill storage of fish and cold storage of fish are introduced. The topics related to types of fish storage, functions of cold storage, and types of cold storage have been removed. Instead, "Transportation of live fish and shellfish" is suggested.

SEMESTER – VI

GCC – VIII – Fisheries Administration and Legislation: The entire syllabus has been revised.

Value-Added Course – Azolla Cultivation is only suggested for Semester – V. "Ornamental Fish Culture" is suggested for Semester – VI, and the entire syllabus of ornamental fish culture has also been revised.
