

He also discussed about copyrighting journal articles for researchers and academicians and when to patent an invention before publishing details in a journal as it is crucial to prevent others from claiming the invention.





The department of mathematics organized a guest lecture on the topic 'An introduction to MATLAB and PYTHON' at AV Room on 05.02.2024. Dr.C.Vijayalakshmi, Associate Professor, Department of Statistics and Applied Mathematics, Central University of Tamilnadu acted as the resource person. The programme began with a prayer song. The Head of the department of mathematics Dr.N.Sarala welcomed the gathering. The programmeco-ordinatorMrs.M.Prabayathy presented the chief guest introduction. chairman Dr.R.Anbuselvi, Principal and DBT gave Presidential Address. Dr.R.SophiaPorchelvi, DBT Programme Co-ordinator cum Controller of Examinations felicitated the programme.

Professor.Vijayalakshmi started her lecture by giving a nice introduction about the importance of learning mathematical soft wares and programming languages especially about Artificial intelligence. She presented the lecture into two sessions. In the first session, the resource person explained about the importance of MATLAB. She elaborated the following:MATLAB, short for Matrix Laboratory, is a powerful and versatile software tool widely used in various fields such as mathematics, engineering and finance. MATLAB provides extensive tools and functions that facilitate data analysis, algorithm development, visualization, and numerical computations. Its intuitive programming language and rich interactive environment make it popular among researchers, engineers, and data scientists. The heart of MATLAB is the MATLAB language, a matrix-based language allowing the most natural expression of computational mathematics.MATLAB operates primarily on arrays and matrices, both in whole and in part. A matrix is a two-dimensional array often used for linear algebra. Variables in MATLAB are typically arrays that can hold many numbers. MATLAB is proprietary software and is not available for free.

In the second session, the resource person explained briefly about the Python programming. She insisted that Python is a popular and user friendly programming language. It mainly used in mathematical calculations, web development and software development. Python can be used to handle big data and perform complex mathematics. Python works on different platforms such as Windows, Linux, etc. This has a simple syntax

similar to the English language and it allows developers to write programs with fewer lines than some other programming languages.

The insights given by the resource person was useful to the students of Department of Mathematics. Ms. K. Harini from III B.Sc Mathematics, Ms. S.K.Jaisrree from II B.Sc Mathematics, Ms. Deepika from I B.Sc Mathematics gave feedback about the programme. Nearly 86 UG students benefitted by this programme. The programme coordinator Mrs.P.Hameetha Begum proposed vote of thanks. The function came to an end with the national anthem. The programmeco-ordinators and other faculty members of department of mathematics made all the necessary arrangements.

He has worked in topmost institutions like Central University, NIT Tiruchirapalli, Indian Institute Trivandrum and he is expert in handling Mathematical softwares.

The programme started with a welcome address by Dr. N. Sarala, Associate Professor and Head of Mathematics. Dr. R.Anbuselvi, Principal and DBT Chairman gave Presidential Address. Principal in her presidential address insisted the importance of Mathematical softwares and advised the students to make use of the workshop. Dr.R.Vanitha , Associate Professor of Mathematics introduced the resource person. She highlighted the GATE qualification, awards, publication and research works done by the resource person.

Dr. V.Balakumar, in the first session explained the version of Geogebra, the tool bars and usage of it, the ways to visualize the 3D objects using Geogebra. He used the downloadable version of Geogebra on screen and explained the various tools practically. In the session 2, Dr. V. Balakumar explained the coding of Scilab. He demonstrated Scilab to solve matrices problems, algebraic and numerical problems.

The students were taken to EDUSAT Lab for the afternoon session for hands on training. 94 students of B.Sc Mathematics, B.Sc Computer Science and BCA practiced the Mathematical tool on their own and cleared their doubts with the help of resource person. In the Valedictory students gave feedback that the workshop was very useful and they were excited to form the 3D shapes using Geogebra. 

PG Department of Computer Science organizes the seminar on "AI WITH BIOINFORMATICS" on 03.01.2024 Dr.SanjayBankapur, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Science and Engineering, National Institute of Technology, Karaikal was the resource persons of the Seminar.





Dr.R.Anbuselvi, Principal, A.D.M College for Women (A), Nagapattinam delivered the presidential address. Dr.R.SophiaPorchelvi, Programme Co-ordinator, DBT Star College Scheme, A.D.M College for Women (A), Nagapattinam gave felicitation Address.

The resource person gave the lecture about Bioinformatics is the application of tools of computation and analysis to the capture and interpretation of biological data. An unprecedented wealth of biological data has been generated by the human genome project and sequencing projects in other organisms. The huge demand for analysis and interpretation of these data is being managed by the evolving science of bioinformatics. It is an interdisciplinary field, which harnesses computer science, mathematics, physics, and biology.

He taught AI in bioinformatics includes both basic as well as clinical research with the help of biological sequence matching, protein-protein interaction and functionstructure analysis. This analysis helps in the design and discovery of drugs as well as complex systems.

He explained about Proteins are linear chain of amino acids. It is encoded in the standard 25-character alphabet, with 20 characters for standard amino acids, 2 for non-standard, 2 for ambiguous and 1 for unknown. Throughout the discussion, any protein x of length L is a sequence of 20 discrete amino acid character ($x_1, x_2, ..., x_{20}$).




Minutes
