

The students learnt how to improve financial management documentation in group projects.


- The issues and challenges in that field as they have to face and how to overcome from things.


Date: 22.11.2023

- The trainer also informed about the necessity of a resounding portfolio.


Date: 27.11.2023

Date:22.11.2023

The Programme was scheduled for Biochemistry, Zoology and Botany students. The session was started in the topic as Qualitative test for Carbohydrates (urine sample & Blank Solution) Reducing and Non-reducing sugars.



The Students were taught to find Blood grouptechniques, Blood Smear, Blood cells(WBC,RBC and Platelet) identification in instrumentation room. The main function is to promote the students as how Carbohydrates play an important role in the structure and function of cells, tissues, organs and estimation of Calcium, Glucose, Sodium, Potassium, Bicarbonate, Chloride, Blood urea, Creatine(using semi auto analyzer instruments) and Liver Function test.

Date:23.11.2023

The topic is Qualitative analysis of Carbohydratesis clearly understood by our students by several tests such as Molisch's test, Fehling's test, Benedict's test, Tollen's test, Iodine test.



The Qualitative analysis of carbohydrates is detected, based on reagent's utilization and the reaction between the test sample and reagent. The performance of the students in finding out the required object is very excellent and the students were able to do themselves the test and to the other students in a massive manner.

Date: 24.11.2023

Qualitative analysis of Aminoacids like Ninhyrin test,Xanthoproteic test, Pauly'sTiazo test, Millon's test, Histidire test, Hopkin'scole test.

It is an analytical method taught by the experts to our students which detects the presence or absence of amino acids in a solution. The students have done the practical session in an excellent manner.



Date:25.11.2023

The four major blood types were elaborated to the students as they are Type A, Type B, Type AB, Type O,RH types Positive, Negative. The blood group is determined by the genes as we inherit from our parents.



The ABO system is the best known way of classifying blood types. Karl Landsteiner has been credited for the discovery of ABO blood group system in 1,900. They also learnt Air bone disease, water born disease and vaccination role in human body. Apart from theory, practical sessions were done by our students that were memorable to them always.

Date: 27.11.2023

Measurement of human blood pressure, Ketone bodies test, Rothera's test, Common hematology test, White blood cell count (WBC), Red Blood cell count (RBC), Platelet count, Hemotocrit Red blood cell volume (HCT), Haemoglobin concentration(HB) were taught. Differential white blood count, Red blood cell indices (measurements)ESR count. Our students were trained skillfully. Blood pressure is a measure of the force that our heart uses to pump blood around the body. They learnt how and where to measure blood pressure and why it's important to know the numbers.



The B.P was measured, continues passive movements and provided reports generated by different medical equipment. Every person coming for the camp had been registered by the registration committee. The students were divided according to the task assigned in medical checkup. In the BP report Systolic and diastolic pressure readings were mentioned according to BP apparatus reading.

The quantity of oxygen present in the blood and the rate of heart were measured by pulse oximeter equipment.



After doing all the checkup a feedback counter was there to take feedback of various patients. The main aim of the camp is to create health awareness among the staffs and students and after that this camp has induced our student to organize more camps in the near future.

The camp did registration screening of all individuals, consultation from doctors. To lay emphasis upon the importance of one's health is the main objective of the camp. The camp was a successful attempt to inculcate the values and the spirit of giving back to society in whatever little way one could, among students. The students developed the leadership qualities and learnt to work as a team. An eye camp was arranged, people came checked their eyes and doctors gave suggestions that was very useful for them.

Date: 28.11.2023

The topic is Blood culture. According to it a health care professional will take a blood sample from a vein in the armusing a small needle. After the needle is inserted, a small amount of blood will be collected into a test tube.



It is done to check if bacteria or fungi are infecting the blood. A blood infection occurs with other serious infections, which includes lungs, Kidneys, Bowels, Gall bladder(Heart)valves. If immune system is weak it happens.

Date: 29.11.2023

The students were taken to Vinayaga Mission Medical College, Hospital, Karaikal by contacting the Dean of the hospital, under his consent students were allowed to do the medical screening test in the laboratory.



They visited all labs in the college especially of Biochemistry, Anatomy, Microbiology, Physiology, Pathalogy, Histology, Instrumentation and blood unit centre. Our students were the beneficiaries.



Date: 30.11.2023

Wound culture was taught as health care provider uses a special swab to collect a sample from the site of the wound, Sputum culture. The person may be asked to cough up sputum into a special cup or a special swab may be used to take a sample from his / her nose.



A culture is a test to find germs of bacteria or a fungus that cause an infection.A sensitivitytest checks to see what kind of medicine is to be given such as an antibiotic will work best to treat the illness or infections.



Date:02.12.2023

Medical screening camp: The topic underwent was Thyroid hormone, Vitamins, Immunoglobulintest, Human chorionic gonadotropin. Recent disease awareness like diabetes Mellitus Type 1 and 2, Diabetic insipid us, Ketoacidosis.



The technology and equipment used for collection of blood was made familiar. The various processes involved in collection, separation and storage of blood, its components was explained. Discussion on the difficulties faced and possible solution to overcome was held. The topic is importance of hand washing, personal hygiene and importance of minerals. To help, prevent and control the spread of many illnesses the importance of these things were given awareness.



Minerals are vital components of our food. They fulfill a wide variety of functions such as building materials for our bones, influencing muscles and nerve function, regulating the body's water balance. They are also components of hormones, enzymes, other biologically active compounds. The programme has moulded our students for a career in medical laboratory settings. They have equipped their skills and knowledge to perform laboratory tests, analyze specimens and contribute the delivery quality of health care services.
