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Resolution

The Academic Council resolved to approve the structure, scheme and syllabi of all discipline with the following suggestions:

General Suggestions

- 1. Gender Studies (GS) can be included in all UG courses.
- Value Education (VE) and Environmental Studies (EVS) have to be given in one semester as studied earlier not as a continuation course in two semesters.
- 3. NME Courses may be offered in II & III semesters instead of I & II semesters.
- 4. Skill Enhancement courses offered from other disciplines must be handled by the faculty from the disciplines concerned.
- 5. 25 % of modifications may be done in the scheme and structure as well as in the syllabi.
- 6. A common scheme and structure has to be framed for the departments by referring the revised University model.
- 7. External evaluation can be made for all the courses in Part IV category (SEC / AECC/ Internship, etc.)
- 8. It is advised that all the Core Courses are to be in sequential order.
- 9. Projects may be made compulsory for UG programmes.
- 10. MOOC Courses and Research related courses need not be made compulsory at UG level.
- 11. Equivalent to Nann Muthalvan Scheme, Self Learning Courses and Extra Credit Courses may be introduced.
- 12. Elective Courses must be given with options.
- 13. As preferred by Bharathidasan University, Extra Credits with Instruction hours have to be included in both UG & PG Programmes.
- 14. Professional Competency Skill must be given in the last semester and the content must enhance the professional ability of the students.
- 15. PO, CO, PSO, PEO and mappings have to be checked and corrected.

History



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It is suggested to change the title as 'Regional History (History of Nagapattinam)' instead of 'Regional History (History of Chennai)'.

Mathematics

The title of the paper 'LaTex' can be changed as 'Document Preparation using LaTex' in UG Mathematics.

Chemistry

- For I B.Sc Chemistry, Biological Science Course (Both Botany & Zoology combined) may be introduced as an Allied Course.
- It is advised to increase the number of practicals in PG Chemistry.

Zoology

Research Methodology Course in M.Sc Zoology must include a topic on 'Thesis writing'.

Commerce

For M.Com (IV Semester), repetition of Elective Course 'Insolvency Law and Practice' must be avoided.

Tamil

The title of the course 'Oodagaviyal' can be changed as 'Oodagaviyal - Oor Arimugam' .

English

- It is advised to give 6 Instruction hours to Part II English Course.
- Thirukkural may be added in 'Indian writing in Translation'.
- The core course title 'English Language teaching' can be changed to 'Introduction to English Language Teaching' and 'Introduction to Literature' can be 'Introduction to English Literature'.
- Instead of Elective Course 'Arts & Literature', Journalism can be offered.

Computer Science

The Electives must be different for B.Sc Computer Science/ BCA/ B.Sc Informational Technology and may be reduced to two papers instead of three.

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B.B.A

In BBA allied Course 'Business Statistics' can be changed as 'Business Mathematics and Statistics'. Research Methodology need not be offered for UG Course.

Geology

- For I B.Sc Geology, allied chemistry can also be given as an option for pure science students.
- Allied practical is included in II Semester.

Economics and Biochemistry

Received general suggestions and were incorporated.

Physics, Botany and Statistics

The syllabi of Physics, Botany and Statistics were also presented and received no comments.

B.Voc Software development in multimedia and Animations

The nomenclature of B.Voc Software development in multimedia and Animations has to be changed as B.Voc Multimedia and Animations and the committee advised to represent this matter to the University.
