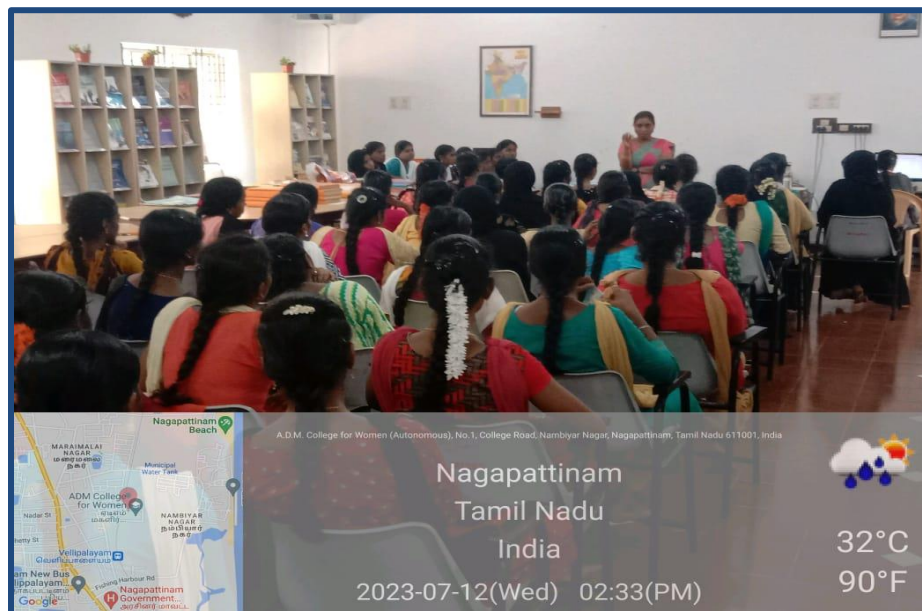
## LIBRARY ORIENTATION PROGRAMME
